New Update as of 4pm, February 22, 2018. Due to projected weather conditions and unplanned events, the previously announced construction schedule on February 16 has been modified. The previously announced new traffic patterns to include new entrance to the "Pork Chop", slug station temporary locations, permanent closure of on-ramp from "Pork Chop" to 110 and reduced S-C permit parking at the "Pork Chop" is now projected to begin mid-March, on or about 5am, Monday, March 19, subject to weather condition. However, construction during the nighttime and weekends will continue at the "Pork Chop" for the next 3 weeks beginning Monday, February 26 through 5am, Monday, March







19. During this time, vehicle and slug traffic entering the "Pork Chop" will remain at the existing entrance at the intersection of Eads Street and South Rotary Road. On-ramp from the "Pork Chop" to 110 will remain open. Slug stations will remain at the current locations by the existing sidewalk. Traffic patterns remain unchanged.

On or about Monday, March 19 (new date subject to weather condition), current slug stations (Burke/Springfield, Tacketts' Mill/Lorton/VRE, Montclair Route 234, Horner Road/Potomac Mills) will continue to be available within the Pork Chop in the same order, but in temporary locations (see diagram). Please follow signage and new traffic pattern.
