## 395 Express Lanes Project Construction to Begin this Summer



Late this summer, those using I-395 between Edsall Road and the Washington, D.C. line will likely notice construction commencing for the 395 Express Lanes Project. The project converts the two existing reversible High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to three managed Express Lanes for approximately eight miles. ## Hayes Street Parking Lot Construction Planned to Begin in Late Summer

Temporary variable message signs will be placed at the Hayes Street Parking Lot to notify users of the construction that is planned to begin in late summer. The Hayes Street lot will be under construction to accommodate the relocation of the Visitor Tour Bus Parking area from the Pentagon South Parking Lot to the eastern portion of the Hayes Street lot. This will convert approximately 155 car parking spaces into 6 tour bus drop-off spaces.

The western portion of the Hayes Street lot will remain open during construction, with the exception of periodic weekends. Project workers will maintain pedestrian access at all times during construction.
